To enter the competition, you will need to submit a high-quality pdf or jpg sent in an email to UNESCO.NZ@education.govt.nz by 31 October 2021, along with this competition entry form.

Only one entry per designer can be submitted.

No designs which have previously been published can be entered.

By entering this competition, you agree that the NZ National Commission for UNESCO can feature the chosen design or artwork on their website and that the design can be used on NZ National Commission for UNESCO's work to support the Decade of Ocean Science throughout the duration of the Decade.

Prizes

- \$5k in cash for the winning design
- Honourable mentions on the website for up to 5 more outstanding designs

Important Dates

Between 28 September and 31 October 2021:

- Design your visual concept
- · Submit your final design

The competition closes on 31 October 2021 at 11.59pm.

Once your design is submitted:

• There will be a 2-week judging period when members of the National Decade Committee (Professor Huhana Smith, Dr Ocean Mercier and Dr Dan Hikuroa) select the winning design.

15 November 2021:

- The winner will be notified.
- The designers of up to 5 more visual concepts will be notified and receive honourable mentions on the website.

15 – 19 November 2021:

• Designs will be published on the website Te Tini a Tangaroa.

Once the winner is announced:

The winning design will be integrated on the website and other UN Ocean Decade communication tools.

A confirmation of entry will be emailed upon receipt of the design submissions. The winner and up to 5 other designers receiving honourable mentions will be contacted directly on 15 November 2021.
